The Wonder of it All: The Heart of it All

In a previous article, I wrote about the wonder of the miracle of birth; how a baby who has spent its whole life so far in a 'water world' can quickly and safely transition to living 'on land'. (ARKY's News Vol 21. No. 1, Pg. 2)

But that wondrous event was preceded by nine months of wonder upon wonder as that baby developed. It starts with the miracle of conception itself; how DNA from two separate beings can zip themselves together to create a completely new person. Then continuing as a single cell, it divides, and divides countless times. Soon these multiplying cells start becoming different types of cells, to eventually make up the over 200 types of cells we have in our body; skin, muscle, bone, nerves, and the many different cells making up each of our organs.

How any one who understands this process can still believe this all came about over eons by chance processes, is itself, almost unbelievable. Rather we should see our loving creator's hand in all this and worship him for it.

The first organ to develop is the heart; before brain, skeleton or even skin. This makes sense, for nutrition needs to be pumped to all the other developing cells and organs as soon as possible. But the heart does not start as a tiny facsimile of the adult heart. Rather it starts out as two 'simple' tubes coming together and undulating to pump nutrients to the rest of the tiny developing baby. These tubes eventually develop into the left ventricle of the heart. But before that, they go through a process called heart looping, where the tube transforms through a number of complex and coordinated twists. Simultaneously, other parts of the heart are also forming, and all parts migrate together at the proper time.

Once things are in place then parts fuse together to make the adult form of the heart. But recall from my previous article, that even this heart operates differently until birth when the valve between chambers closes up with the baby's first breath.

Scientists do not know why the heart develops this way. But the process; indeed, the whole fetal development process loudly defies any attempt to explain how this could have evolved. I speculate that this process was the fastest way to get the blood pumping, and to continue pumping throughout all its intermediate states! Truly a marvel of God's loving design.

This same organ, first to appear on the scene, continues literally for a lifetime. You can survive without some other organs, but once the heart stops, your life on earth ends. It is fitting that the Bible has many references to the heart, and that it is often equated to the center of your being. I will close with a few of these verses.

Humanism as Religion: Perks and Limitations

Should humanists have the same rights or “perks” as other religious groups? That question has been the subject of debate for decades, dating all the way back to the 1961 Supreme Court case of *Torcaso v. Watkins*.^[i] The ruling opinion of that case, along with the opinion of a more recent U.S. District Court Case, *American Humanists v. U.S.*, classified humanism as a religion in order to protect the free exercise of humanist beliefs.^[ii]

Now, I understand that some Christians are concerned about humanism enjoying the “perks” of the official, religious status. For example, some are concerned about negative consequences of military services employing humanist chaplains. While I can empathize with these types of concerns, I believe classifying humanism as a religion should be culturally accepted for the sake of Truth. I can think of two major advantages of pragmatically and legally classifying humanism as a religion:



1. Classifying humanism as a religion reveals an important truth: humanists worship a god, even if that god is the god of self.

2. If humanism is going to enjoy “perks” of religious status, then it should also be subject to the same limitations. In today’s culture, the religion of humanism enjoys free reign behind various veils and masks such as so-called “civil rights” and “science.”

Therefore, while I was examining the Friendly Atheist Facebook page's posts one evening, there was one post that immediately caught my attention. The Friendly Atheist blogger, Hemant Mehta, posted the following:

Should Nevada give atheist prisoners the same perks afforded to religious inmates? That's the question at the heart of a major legal battle going on right now.

As always, there were numerous supporting comments in reply to Hemant Mehta's post. I chose to respond to one particular comment, posted by humanist JD. Below is Part 1 of 6 of the Humanism as Religion Debate, which consists of JD's comment and my reply.

JD: They want the Torah, Holy Bible, and Qur'an? Fantastic. I want copies of *The End of Faith*, *The God Delusion*, and *God is Not Great* available please.

Me: I agree with the position that humanism is a religion, which certainly requires certain rights or “perks” in accordance with the constitution. By the same token, If the religion of humanism should enjoy the same perks as other religions, shouldn't it also be subject to the same limitations due to the establishment clause? For example, if the Bible and its teachings are not allowed to be taught in public schools, then shouldn't *The God Delusion* and other humanist works be banned from the public classroom as well? Similarly, if biblical creation should be banned from the public classroom, then shouldn't unverifiable evolutionary ideas (life evolving from non-life, complex “upward” evolution such as an originally-blind organism evolving eyesight, etc.) be banned from the classroom as well (or, should schools just allow the teaching of both worldviews)?

JD's comment and my reply set the stage for the rest of the debate. Five other humanists joined the discussion, and the whole debate thread turned out to be rather fascinating and revealing. This is one of my favorite discussions to date. I will share Part 2 of 6 of the debate in my next post.



Oort Cloud—No Evidence Required

Most evolutionary astronomers talk about the Oort cloud like it's a fact. Yet they admit no direct observational evidence exists.

When I was growing up, the definition of science was simple: "the study of the natural world using the five senses." This definition placed some limits upon science. For instance, science was restricted to the study of the natural world, so anything supernatural was out of bounds to science. Supernatural things include miracles, angels, souls, and God. Even if something is part of the natural world, it wasn't considered scientific unless we could detect it with our five senses.

Over the years, however, many scientists found this definition too confining. So they gradually redefined science as "the search for natural explanations." This newfangled view of "science" studies things we can't even detect. The Oort cloud is a good example. It was included among the "11 Scientific Wonders We Know Exist—but We've Never Seen" featured in a cover article in *New Scientist* last year.

Catastrophe or Cataclysm

"[God] spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly; And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly." (2 Peter 2:5-6)

These two verses speak graphically of two different kinds of terrible physical convulsions, both of which were divine judgments. The volcanic upheaval that sent fire from heaven pouring over the wicked cities of the plains was called an "overthrow" (Greek *katastrophe*, from which, obviously, we get our English word "catastrophe"). Great upheavals such as volcanic eruptions, earthquakes, and hurricanes are rightly called catastrophes.

But such events are only local or regional in extent and occur relatively often. There was one event, however, that was unique in all history. When God brought the "flood" upon the ungodly antediluvian world, the word used to describe it was the Greek *kataklysmos*, and this word is never applied in Scripture to any event except the terrible Genesis Flood, when "the world that then was, being overflowed [Greek *kataklyuzo*] with water, perished" (2 Peter 3:6). From these Greek words we derive the English word "cataclysm."

There was never any flood like this flood! It covered all the world's mountains, and everything on the land died, leaving great fossil deposits and great beds of lithified sediments all over the world.

There has been only one worldwide cataclysm in the past, but another is coming—global fire instead of global water. Jesus said, "For as in the days that were before the flood [i.e., *kataklysmos*] they . . . knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be" (Matthew 24:38-

39).

What is the Oort cloud? Science textbooks and magazines are filled with impressive illustrations of a huge shell around our solar system where long-period comets come from. (Long-period comets are those comets that generally have orbital periods greater than two centuries—meaning they must travel a great distance to reach our sun.)

Why do so many scientists treat the Oort cloud as fact? If comets formed billions of years ago, then you have a huge problem to solve. Comets are relatively fragile. They consist of a nucleus made primarily of ice. Mixed in with the ice are very fine solid particles of dust. The ice stays frozen while a comet is far from the sun, where it is very cold. But when it comes close to the sun, the heat evaporates some of the ice, dislodging dust particles and forming long tails. While briefly near the sun, comets can become very bright before rapidly fading from view.

But this brief glory comes at a price. Eventually, comets lose so much ice that they can no longer glow brightly. Astronomers estimate that comets likely cannot survive a hundred trips around the sun. To make matters worse, two other mechanisms destroy comets. The gravity of the larger planets, such as Jupiter, can kick them out of the solar system, never to return. Also, comets occasionally collide with planets and disintegrate. Astronomers watched this happen to Comet Shoemaker-Levy 9 in 1994.

If the solar system were only a few hundred million years old (that's nowhere near the supposed age of the universe), no more comets would remain. But most scientists think the solar system is 4.6 billion years old, so why do we still see comets? To solve this dilemma, in 1950 the Dutch astronomer Jan Oort suggested that many comet nuclei orbit the sun tens of thousands of times farther out than the earth's orbit. The gravity of a star or other large object passing near the Oort cloud supposedly would cause nuclei to fall inward toward the sun. Thus, new comets would replace older comets that die off.

Can we see this Oort comet cloud? Hardly. Remember that comet nuclei are very small. When far from the sun, they shine only by reflecting sunlight. But at such great distances, the sun's light is very dim. Consequently, comet nuclei in the Oort cloud would be too faint for us to see. More than 30 years ago, astronomer Carl Sagan said it well: "Many scientific papers are written each year about the Oort cloud, its properties, its origin, its evolution. Yet there is not yet a shred of direct observational evidence for its existence."

The situation has not changed since then, despite the constant flow of magazine articles and technical papers. Since there is no detectable evidence for the Oort cloud's existence, it fails to qualify as a scientific idea by the older definition of science. However, the new definition doesn't require any hard evidence. Rather, it qualifies as scientific simply because it is a "natural" explanation.

That's a dangerous drift. The new, looser definition of science appeals to many scientists because it allows them to include many things, such as the Oort cloud, under the respected banner of "science," contrary to the earlier mindset.

But this new definition has a much more insidious side. It implies that only the natural world is worthy of study and respect. Indeed, many advocates go further and argue that only "natural" phenomena exist, and hence they exclude any possibility that God exists.

How ironic. Something which we have no evidence for—except the imagination of evolutionary scientists who are desperate to defend their unfounded beliefs—is treated as fact because it's "natural." Meanwhile, the eternal being who preceded nature and brought it into existence is not considered a fact because he is not "natural." Whom should we believe?
