In the span of just a few months, the ARK Foundation lost its founders Ron and Brenda Cooper, Ron on June 3rd and Brenda on October 10th.

I was first introduced to Ron at the Answers in Genesis conference which he helped organize at the Nutter center back in 1995. It was a great foundational event for my own children's faith walks. Although I did not become more involved with the ARK foundation for about another 15 years, the event was also a step in my growing love for the Bible and all the scientific evidence that affirms its truth rather than contradict it as the world wants you to believe.

Ron dreamed big. He even dreamed of building a life-sized Noah's ark in Dayton. But after learning from Ken Ham of Ken's goal of building one, Ron decided to let Ken do it. Ron had other dreams of ways to bring the truth of the Bible to the public, and some of them did come to fruition.

These are some of Ron's faith steps that I am aware of. He took a step of faith when, with a group of other like-minded believers, formed the fledgling ARK foundation of Dayton. He took a step of faith when that new ARK Foundation helped bring Answers in Genesis to Dayton to put on a conference in the then new Nutter Cen-

ter. He took a step of faith when he purchased a building and opened a Christian bookstore dedicated to selling material that sold Bible honoring scientific literature and other Bible honoring, Christ honoring material. He took a step of faith when he purchased a trailer and took ARK Foundation on the road. He took a step of faith when he took over the organizing of the Dayton Resource & Curriculum Fair (DRCF) helping get Christ honoring and Bible honoring curricula into homeschools. Only the Lord knows how many lives were impacted through Ron's steps of faith.



May the impact of his faithfulness continue on into the next generation of believers embracing the complete trustworthiness of the Bible from the very first verse to the very last.

It was a privilege to take over the reigns from Ron when he stepped down in 2018. Though I do not

The Wonder of it All - The Heavens Declare, and the Perfect Word (Psalm 19)

Anyone who is even partly familiar with Creation Science will be familiar with the verse “The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.” (NIV) This is indeed a powerful verse that Christians can readily see the truth of in the discoveries of science. But by stopping there, we miss the full impact of the Psalm that starts off with this statement. The next five verses continue the theme. Without saying a physical word, the heavens “pour forth speech” (v2). No sound is heard, “Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world.” (v4) Without saying a word, the heavens testify to God’s creative handiwork.

The next few verses (v4b – 6) focuses in on the sun, one very special body within the heavens that declare God’s glory. The sun truly is a special creation in God’s heavens that merits special mention. We have previously covered some of the uniqueness in my Wonder of it All article “Our Nearly Perfect Star” (Volume 23, #3, Oct 2017). In this Psalm, the sun is described in some beautiful imagery; “like a champion rejoicing to run his course” (v5). While some skeptics may see verse 6 “It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other” and claim that this shows the psalmist believed the sun revolved around the earth, that is not the case. We today use the same imagery when we say the sun rises in the east and sets in the west.

Then the Psalm seems to take on a totally new subject starting in verse 7 in describing attributes of the Word of the Lord. For the longest time, I could not figure out how these two halves of Psalm 19 fit together, though each section is powerful in its own right. Finally, in my latter years, I heard a teaching that led me to see how the sections wonderfully fit together. The first six verses are a description of God’s creation giving glory to him, what we sometimes call general revelation. Paul crystallized this concept in Romans 1:20-23 where he spells out that God’s “invisible attributes,

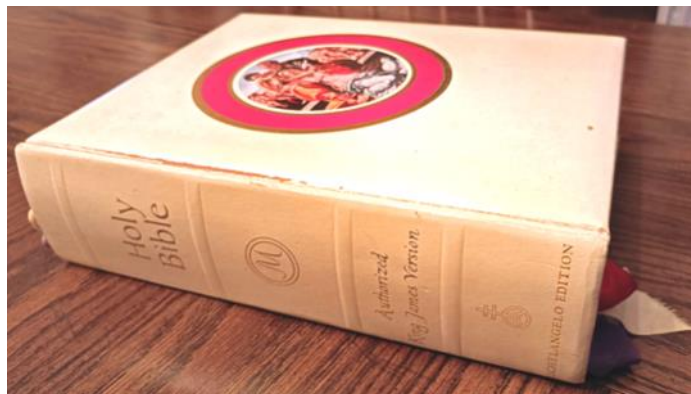
His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made” (Rom 1:20). Sadly, as Paul describes in his letter, mankind has rejected this revelation of God through His creation.

But general revelation, as powerful as it is, is insufficient by itself to tell us all we need to know of who this creator God is. That’s where the second part of Psalm 19 fits in; we also need God’s revealed word to tell us who he is, and the depth of his love for us (special revelation). This section starts off with “The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul.” Now, for a time I also struggled with this idea of the “law” being “refreshing” (or “reviving”, KJV) In fact all of Psalm 119 carries that same theme of love for the law. The concept seemed to be in conflict with some of Paul’s other statements such as “because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death.” (Rom 8:2. See also Rom 7:5 and 1 Cor 15:56). But it is not the law that brings death, but the sin nature within us that brings death through the law. The law of God itself is good, and holy, and perfect.

To go a bit deeper, the word here in Psalm 19:7 that is translated as “law” is the Hebrew word “Torah”. So specifically, the passage is referring to the first five books of the Bible, or the “books of Moses”, not just the Levitical laws as I used to believe. But more broadly, it means the Bible, the whole Word of God. The heavens declare the glory of God, but it is the perfect word of the Lord that is “more to be de-

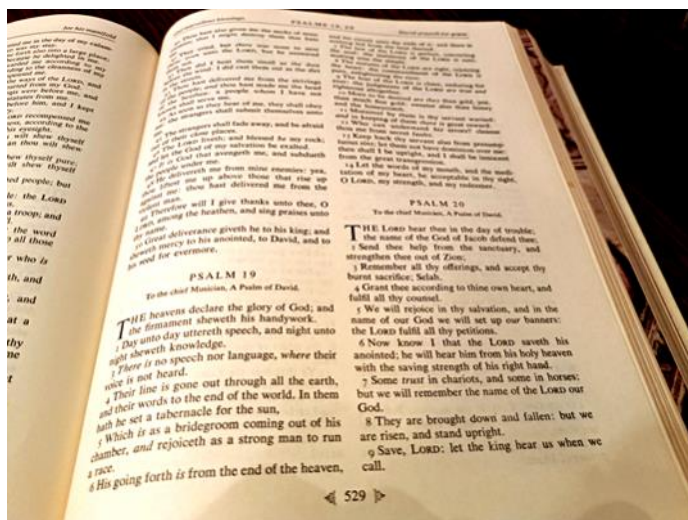

sired than much fine gold.” (v10)

What are the other benefits of the various aspects of the Word of God? (testimony, commandment, judgement,...) It make the simple wise, rejoices the heart, enlightens the eyes, is clean and endures forever, is true and righteous!

We need to wonder at the heavens that declare the glory of God. But let your greater wonder be in daily feeding on his Word. “Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer.” (Ps 19:14, NKJV)

Bird Evolution Debate Intro

Back in May [2018], Hemant Mehta, also known as the "Friendly Atheist," shared a blog post about a fossilized bird with teeth, and made the claim that "No evidence is ever good enough for Creationists." Mr. Mehta presupposes that birds evolved from dinosaurs. To many humanists, dinosaur-to-bird evolution is a foregone conclusion, and creationists who deny this claim are supposedly deniers of science and reality. I decided to engage one particular humanist, JC, who commented on Mr. Mehta's post. Three other humanists joined the thread as well. Three of the four humanists, including JC, were willing to engage in content-based discussion. There was only one humanist that had nothing to share except ad hominem attacks.

See the transcript below for Part 1 of 7 of what I dubbed the "Bird Evolution Debate." Names are abbreviated for privacy and brevity.

JC: Creationists just deny and reject reality. They remind me of a very young kid who doesn't like something will pick up his toys and go home. They constantly reject the facts, reality and science.

Kevin: Actually, creation scientists reject the evolutionary interpretations of the facts; these interpretations are not based on observational science, but are based on evolutionary faith. Do you agree that science is observable, testable and repeatable? If so, one major requirement for supposed dinosaur-to-bird evolution is for the dinosaur to evolve a bird-like respiratory system. Dinosaurs had bellows-type lungs that draw air into tiny sacs called alveoli where red blood cells extract oxygen and allow carbon dioxide to be exhaled out of the same pathway (bidirectional flow). However, birds have a complex system of air sacs that enables air to constantly flow in just one direction (unidirectional flow) through special tubes called parabronchi, where blood moves in the opposite direction for efficient oxygen uptake. The avian lung system enables birds to conserve energy, which is a very helpful design for flight. With all of that being said, can you provide observable evidence of any organism (let alone a dinosaur) evolving from the bidirectional bellows-type lung system to the unidirectional avian-type lung system?

Also, there seems to be so much confusion and disagreement about supposed bird evolution, that even some evolutionary scientists believe in bird-to-dinosaur evolution rather than dinosaur-to-bird evolution. (<https://www.sciencedaily.com/releases/2010/02/100209183335.htm>). Do those evolutionists "reject reality" as well?

JC: Yeah, we don't have all the answers and everything fully understood and explained but I'll follow science before I fall for anymore BS that was shoved down my throat as a child. Creationists can keep their kindergarten rap to themselves!

Kevin: I appreciate the confession that you and other evolutionists do not have all the answers and everything fully understood. Therefore, regarding supposed dinosaur-to-bird evolution, which implies supposed evolution of the respiratory system from bidirectional to unidirectional, is not your trust in that concept based on faith rather than "facts"?

You say that you follow "science," which is observable, testable, and repeatable, but I assume your specific meaning is in regards to the evolutionary worldview. The evolutionary worldview claims that all life evolved from a common ancestor. This requires organisms to add brand new genetic information and functionality over time. For example, this would imply that at some point, or at multiple points in time, an originally-blind organism evolved eyesight, or an originally flightless organism evolved the ability to fly. By what observable evidence do you accept these claims? Or do you accept them by faith?

JC: We keep our minds open to future discoveries. We don't close them with blind faith in something that has absolutely no real evidence. Big difference!

Kevin: If you are unable to answer my questions, then how is your belief in evolution not a "blind faith in something that has absolutely no real evidence"?

Soon after this portion of the discussion, JC shared that his "...biggest brake from religion isn't from evolution but the actual history of the Bible..." I will post that portion of the discussion in my next blog post where I share Part 2 of the Bird Evolution Debate.

Folded Rock Layers

How could a series of sedimentary layers fold without fracturing? The only way is for all the sedimentary layers to be laid down in rapid succession and then be folded while still soft and pliable.

If the global Flood, as described in Genesis 7 and 8, really occurred, what evidence would we expect to find? Wouldn't we expect to find rock layers all over the earth that are filled with billions of dead animals and plants that were rapidly buried and fossilized in sand, mud, and lime? In these sometimes folded rock layers that's exactly what we find.

The fossil-bearing geologic record consists of tens of thousands of feet of sedimentary layers, though not all these layers are found everywhere around the globe, and their thickness varies from place to place. At most locations only a small portion is available to view, such as about 4,500 feet (1371 m) of strata in the walls of the Grand Canyon.

Uniformitarian (long-age) geologists believe that these sedimentary layers were deposited and deformed over the past 500 million years. If it really did take millions of years, then individual sediment layers would have been deposited slowly and the sequences would have been laid down sporadically. In contrast, if the global cataclysmic Genesis Flood deposited all these strata in a little more than a year, then the individual layers would have been deposited in rapid succession, one on top of the other.

Do we see evidence in the walls of the Grand Canyon that the sedimentary layers were all laid down in quick succession? Yes, absolutely!

The previous article in this series documented the lack of evidence for slow and gradual erosion at the boundaries between the sediment layers. This article explores evidence that the entire sequence of sedimentary strata was still soft during subsequent folding, and the strata experienced only limited fracturing. These rock layers should have broken and shattered during the folding, unless the sediment was still



relatively soft and pliable.

Solid Rock Breaks When Bent

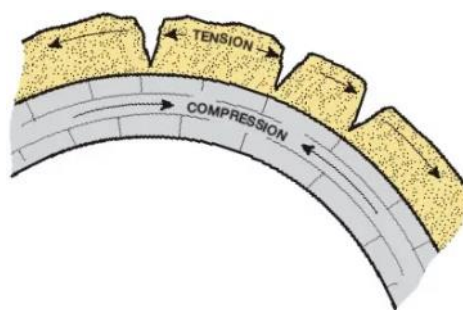


Figure 1: Solid Rock Breaks not Bends

When solid, hard rock is bent (or folded) it invariably fractures and breaks because it is brittle (*Figure 1*). Rock will bend only if it is still soft and pliable—"plastic" like modeling clay or children's Playdough. If such modeling clay is allowed to dry out, it is no longer pliable but hard and brittle, so any attempt to bend it will cause it to break and shatter.

When water deposits sediments in a layer, some water is left behind, trapped between the

sediment grains. Clay particles may also be among the sediment grains. As other sedimentary layers are laid on top of the deposits, the pressure

squeezes the sedimentary particles closer together and forces out much of the water. The earth's internal heat may also remove water from the sediment. As the sediment layer dries out, the chemicals that were in the water and between the clay particles convert into a natural cement. This cement transforms the originally soft and wet sediment layer into a hard, brittle rock layer.

This process, known technically as diagenesis, can be exceedingly rapid. It is known to occur within hours but generally takes days or months, depending on the prevailing conditions. It doesn't take millions of years, even under today's slow-and-gradual geologic conditions.

Folding a Whole Strata Sequence Without Fracturing

The 4,500-foot sequence of sedimentary layers in the walls of the Grand Canyon stands well

above today's sea level. Earth movements in the past pushed up this sedimentary sequence to form the Kaibab Plateau. However, the eastern portion of the sequence (in the eastern Grand Canyon and Marble Canyon areas in

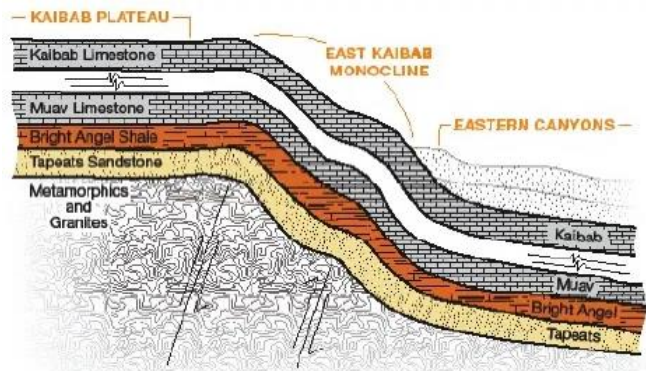


Figure 2: Bent rock layers of the Kaibab Plateau

northern Arizona) was not pushed up as much and is about 2,500 feet (762 m) lower than the height of the Kaibab Plateau. The boundary between the Kaibab Plateau and the less uplifted eastern canyons is marked by a large step-like fold, called the East Kaibab Monocline (Figure 2).

It's possible to see these folded sedimentary layers in several side canyons. For example, the folded Tapeats Sandstone can be seen in Carbon Canyon (Figure 3). Notice that these sandstone layers were bent 90° (a right angle), yet the rock was not fractured or broken at the hinge of the fold. Similarly, the folded Muav and Redwall Limestone layers can be seen along nearby Kwagunt Creek (Figure 4). The folding of these limestones did not cause them to fracture and break, either, as would be expected with ancient brittle rocks. The obvious conclusion is that these sandstone and limestone layers were all folded and bent while the sediments were still soft and pliable, very soon after they were deposited.

Herein lies an insurmountable dilemma for uniformitarian geologists. They maintain that the Tapeats Sandstone and Muav Limestone were deposited 500–520 million years ago; the Redwall Limestone, 330–340 million years ago; then the Kaibab Limestone at the top of the sequence (Figure 2), 260 million years ago. Lastly, the Kaibab Plateau was uplifted (about 60 million years ago), causing the folding. That's a

time span of about 440 million years between the first deposit and the folding. How could the

Tapeats Sandstone and Muav Limestone still be soft and pliable, as though they had just been deposited? Wouldn't

they fracture and shatter if folded 440 million years after deposition?

The conventional explanation is that under the pressure and heat of burial, the hardened sandstone and limestone layers were bent so slowly they behaved as though they were plastic and thus did not break. However, pressure and heat would have caused detectable changes in the minerals of these rocks, tell-tale signs of metamorphism. But such metamorphic minerals or recrystallization due to such plastic behavior is not observed in these rocks. The sandstone and limestone in the folds are identical to sedimentary layers elsewhere.

The only logical conclusion is that the 440-million-year delay between deposition and folding never happened! Instead, the Tapeats-Kaibab strata sequence was laid down in rapid succession early during the year of the global cataclysmic Genesis Flood, followed by uplift

of the Kaibab Plateau within the last months of the Flood. This alone explains the folding of the whole strata sequence without appreciable fracturing.

Conclusion

Uniformitarian geologists claim that tens of thousands of feet of fossiliferous sedimentary

layers have been deposited over more than 500 million years. In contrast, the global cataclysmic Flood of Genesis 7–8 leads creation geologists to believe that most of these layers were deposited in just over one year. Thus, during the Flood many different strata would have been laid down in rapid succession.

In the walls of the Grand Canyon, we can see that the whole horizontal sedimentary strata sequence was folded without fracturing, supposedly 440 million years after the Tapeats Sandstone and Muav Limestone were deposited, and 200 million years after the Kaibab Limestone was deposited. The only way to explain how these sandstone and limestone beds could be folded, as though still pliable, is to conclude they were deposited during the Genesis Flood, just months before they were folded.

This geology series documents that, when we accept the Flood of Genesis 7–8 as an actual event in earth history, then we find that the geologic evidence is absolutely in harmony with the Word of God. As the ocean waters flooded over the continents, they must have buried plants and animals in rapid succession. These rapidly deposited sediment layers were spread across vast areas, preserving fossils of sea creatures in layers that are high above the current (receded) sea level. The sand and other sediments in these layers were transported long distances from their original sources. We know that many of these sedimentary strata were laid down in rapid succession because we don't find evidence of slow erosion between the strata.

As expected, the evidence in God's world totally agrees with what we read in God's Word. "Thy word is true from the beginning," the psalmist tells us (Psalm 119:160).

Introducing God

"And he said unto them, I am an Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry land." (Jonah 1:9)

How should believers introduce God to unbelievers? Scripture gives good examples, like the way Jonah defined his God to pagan idolaters onboard a storm-tossed ship. Jonah's God, in magnificent

and holy distinction from their gods, made the universe and all it contains. They soon observed

that He is sovereign over all His creation, including the weather. Stopping the terrible storm required no effort from the Creator. They then "feared the LORD exceedingly" (Jonah 1:16).

In that moment, the crew acknowledged what many idol-worshipping Israelites did not. Thus, Jeremiah had to reintroduce them to "the true God" by saying, "The gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens" (Jeremiah 10:10-11). In contrast, the living God "hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion" (v. 12).

King David also encouraged God's people to introduce God by crediting Him with creation. "Declare his glory among the heathen; his wonders among all people. For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens" (Psalm 96:3-5). And Paul famously introduced God as the Creator to pagan Gentiles in Acts 14:15 and 17:23-25.

God introduces Himself to all who open to the first page of His Word as He who created the heavens and the earth. Do you know someone to whom you can introduce Jesus as Creator? BDT .
